[1] Challenge in the instant petition is to order dated 06.01.2014 passed by the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charkhi Dadri, rejecting the application filed by the petitioner under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC.

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that Civil Suit No.RBT-603 of 2010 filed by respondent Nos.1 & 2 besides Vinod Kumar and Shamsher Singh was dismissed vide judgment and decree dated 31.08.2022 passed by the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), Charkhi Dadra, therefore, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.
