Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.212 dated 06.07.2022 under Sections 336/506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station B-Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the matter has been compromised vide compromise deed dated 22.12.2022 and petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise has been filed before this Court being CRM-M-5586-2023 where on issuance of notice of motion on 03.02.2023, it has been ordered to record the statements of the parties and the same is now fixed for hearing on 03.05.2023.

Vide order dated 21.11.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.11.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuljinder Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 15.12.2022 and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
