1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the notices dated 03.08.2021 and 11.08.2022 (Annexures P-9 and P-11) respectively.

2. Written statement on behalf of respondent no.2 has been filed and the same is taken on record. Learned senior counsel appearing for respondent no.2 has submitted that subsequent to the notices dated 03.08.2021 and 11.08.2022, vide Annexure R-2/12 Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka has withdrawn the mark sheets and degree certificates of the petitioner. It is further submitted that the Council of Indian Medicine Haryana vide order dated 18.05.2023 (Annexure R-2/13)

has withdrawn registration certificate of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the said orders have been passed during the pendency of writ petition, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition challenging the said orders and the petitioner be permitted to raise all the pleas which have been raised in the present petition and are available to him, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition challenging the said orders and in case the petitioner challenges the subsequent orders, it would be open to the petitioner to raise all the pleas which have been raised in the present petition and are available to him, in accordance with law.
