The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.465 dated 21.10.2022 under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

The learned Senior counsel on instructions states that the petitioner has only one Passport bearing No.J0033598 and the same stands expired on 20.04.2020. The petitioner does not have any other passport. He submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 09.12.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

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The learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 09.12.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 09.12.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
