At the outset, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, learned Senior DAG, Punjab has stated that on 18.07.2022, the learned State counsel had made a statement on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar in CRM-M-34860-2020 that the petitioner (respondent No.2 in the present petition) had joined the investigation and was fully co-operating with the investigation process and was not required for custodial interrogation and, therefore, the order by which the interim anticipatory bail was granted was made absolute by this Court.

Today also, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnam Singh who is present in the Court has reiterated the aforesaid statement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the aforesaid position, he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition.
