1. Through this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners namely Jasvir Kaur, aged about 35 years and Gurmail Singh, aged about 53 years, have approached this Court seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to protect their life and liberty threatened at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 7.

2. It is pleaded that both the petitioners are married to their respective spouses and have children from these marriages. Both of them are living separately from their respective spouses and after taking divorce from their respective partners, they want to marry each other.

Apprehending threat from the private respondents, the present petition has been filed.

3. Status report by way of affidavit dated 11.12.2023 has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record. Learned State counsel submits that the matter has been thoroughly investigated and statements of the private parties have been recorded. The petitioners have categorically submitted therein that they have no apprehension of danger of any kind at the hands of private respondents and they do not want to pursue the present petition.

4. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.

5. The petition is disposed of.
