MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (*for short 'Cr.P.C.'*) for transfer of investigation in FIR No.215 dated 04.09.2022, under Sections 306, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

(2) In nutshell, grievance of the petitioner would be that complainant is an influential person and having good relations with police officials in District Bathinda; therefore, investigation be transferred to some other district; that too by an Officer in the rank of ADGP.

(3) Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Buta Singh apprised the Court that after investigation, report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

has already been submitted before the Court of competent jurisdiction and the matter is pending for consideration of charges.

(4) In view of the above factual position, this Court is not inclined to entertain the prayer of petitioner.

Consequently, the petition is disposed off.

(5) However, petitioner would be at liberty to raise all her pleas at appropriate stage(s) before the Court concerned.

(6) Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
