HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the order of the transfer dated 01.09.2023, a copy of which has been appended with this petition as Annexure P-4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner has been transferred from Ladwa (Kurukshetra) where the petitioner had an additional charge of Yamunanagar as well in the cadre of AFSO within a period of one year, four months of his stay at the said place of posting, which is contrary to the policy, which has been issued by the respondent-State for effecting the transfer.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though as an obedient employee of the Department, the petitioner has joined the transferred post but submitted a representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure

P-11) to reconsider the said transfer and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case the representation of the petitioner is decided by the respondents in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order keeping in view the grounds raised therein.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 22.09.2023 (Annexure P-11) is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the respondents within a period of four weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

8. Ordered accordingly.
