The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to official respondents no.1 to 5 to register an FIR against respondents no.6 and 7 as per complaint dated 23.5.2022 submitted by the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has filed the status report. Same is taken on record. He submits that after death of son of the petitioner proceedings under Section 174 Cr.P.C were carried out vide DDR No.15 dated 29.4.2022 and it was found to be a case of accident. It is also submitted that no foul play was found in the matter. It is further submitted that postmortem of the dead body was conducted and cause of death was found to be Polytrauma which was antemortem in nature and sufficient to cause death.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail the alternate remedies as may be available to him in accordance with law.
