Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.148 dated 29.3.2022 registered under Sections 186, 332, 353, 500, 504, 341 IPC (Section 395 IPC and Section 67 of IT Act deleted later on) at Police Station Civil Lines Sirsa, District Sirsa.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed by this Court whereby the petitioner was granted interim bail with direction to join the investigation.

Today, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner apprised the Court that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

State counsel on instructions from SI Ran Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
