Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No. 145, dated 29.09.2021, under Section 379-B (Section 411 added later on) of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Verka, District Amritsar.

[2] Main case stood listed for hearing on 12.07.2023.

[3] Now, two applications have been moved on behalf of the applicant-petitioner, i.e. (i) CRM No. 26568 of 2023 for preponment of the main case from 12.07.2023; and (ii) CRM No. 26570 of 2023 for withdrawal of main case with liberty to file fresh petition before the learned trial Court.

[4] In CRM No. 26570 of 2023, it is averred that since the complainant has turned hostile before the learned trial Court; therefore

the petitioner wishes for withdrawal of the main case with liberty to approach the learned trial Court for seeking regular bail.

[5] Notice of both the aforesaid applications.

[6] Ms. Monika Jalota, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice of the applications and has no objection against the prayer made therein.

[7] On the oral request of learned counsel for parties, application bearing **CRM No. 26568 of 2023** is **allowed**; main case is preponed from 12.07.2023 and taken up today itself.

[8] In view of the above and contents of the application bearing **CRM No. 26570 of 2023**, same is **allowed**; and the main case is **dismissed as withdrawn** with the liberty, as prayed for.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
