Challenge in the present petition is to the communication/letter dated 29.08.2023 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.4-SHO, Police Station Sadar Dabwali, Sirsa, whereby the petitioner's right to travel abroad has been curtailed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties i.e. the petitioner and respondent No.5 have mutually resolved their differences and as of now, there is no dispute or issue between them.
