This petition has been filed for grant of regular bail in FIR No.126, dated 01.10.2021, registered at Police Station Maqsudan, District Jalandhar, under Sections 15C and 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 (added lateron).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has undergone actual custody in excess of one year. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 01 PW has been examined. There is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner and thus, he may be granted regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 23.01.2023 checked by Sh.Hemant sharma, Addl. Superintendent, Central Jail, Kapurthala has been filed in Court. The same is taken on record. A perusal thereof shows that the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 01 year, 03 months and 19 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

Learned State counsel concedes that only one PW has been examined till date.

It is thus evident that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. Keeping in view the period of custody undergone as well as the fact that there is no other criminal case pending against the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to grant him regular bail. Accordingly, the petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
