Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the dispute in the present appeal primarily is between the mother-Jasbir Kaur (respondent No.1 herein) and her daughter-Kinder Kaur @ Kulwinder Kaur (appellant herein). Suit filed by respondent No.1-Jasbir Kaur (plaintiff in the civil suit) was decreed and same was upheld in the first appeal as well.

2. Learned counsel further submits that during the pendency of appeal before this Court filed by the appellant-Kinder Kaur @ Kulwinder Kaur (defendant No.1 in the civil suit), respondent No.1-Jasbir Kaur has expired on 08.04.2022 and thereafter, all the rights in the property have been succeeded by defendant No.1/appellant-Kinder Kaur @ Kulwinder herself, being the only child.

3. Learned counsel further submits that in view of the situation explained hereinabove, there is no question left in the present appeal to be decided and thus, the appeal is worth for its disposal being infructuous.

4. Accordingly, present appeal is disposed of being rendered infructuous as stated above.
