The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 113 dated 02.09.2022 under Section 324,307, 34, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Maloya, District Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 13.12.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned Addl. P.P., UT, Chandigarh, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation and that the co-accused(juvenile) has already been released on bail.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is not required for

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custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 13.12.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i), (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
