Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.822 dated 1.10.2017 registered under Sections 379 IPC (Section 420, 201, 467, 468, 471 IPC) at Police Station Suraj Kund, District Faridabad.

The counsel for the petitioner submits that the allegations in nutshell are that 3 unidentified persons snatched Innova Car bearing No.UK-07-BK-2826 which was being driven by the complainant on 1.10.2017 and accordingly, FIR was registered against 3 unidentified persons. He further submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police in compliance of previous order and further apprised the Court that the snatched car was recovered by the police on 6.8.2019.

State counsel on instructions from SI Veer Sen submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police and recovery of the

snatched vehicle is already effected and now the petitioner is not required

for further investigation or custodial interrogation by the police as he cooperated in the investigation and got recovered one Laptop and Printer used in preparing fake registration certificate of the vehicle in question.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 21.11.2022 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
