The petitioners are alleging violation of the order dated 22.03.2022, passed by this Court in CWP-17426-2019, vide which, the writ petition was disposed of in terms of the order passed in **CWP-11641-2019**, titled as ***Pawan Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others***, decided on 17.11.2021.

In ***Pawan Kumar's*** case (supra), it was directed that the official respondents will ensure that the arrears of the salary for the months of April and May, 2021 to those petitioners who have not been paid are also remitted, ***“subject of course to the verification that for the corresponding period they had rendered work.”***

As per affidavit filed by the Civil Surgeon, Sonipat, which is on record, it is stated that after seeking clarification from the Medical Officer Incharge, Primary Health Center, Mohana, no record was found regarding attendance of the petitioners and it was found that the petitioners have not worked for the relevant period.

In view of the above, no case of any willful disobedience is made out.

The present petition is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioners are granted liberty to avail the alternative remedy, in accordance with law, if so advised.
