1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 20.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.4 and order dated 27.03.2019 (Annexure P-8) passed by respondent No.2.
