1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr. P.C with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents to add the offences under Section 326, 354 and 120-B of IPC in case FIR No. 206 dated 03.09.2022, under Sections 323, 341 and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Ludhiana (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned State counsel submits that the investigation in the present case has already been completed and the final report under Section 173 Cr. PC has been prepared. Learned State counsel further submits that the final report of investigation has been prepared for the prosecution of the accused for the offences punishable under Sections 323, 341 and 506 of IPC.

3. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court and petition is accordingly, disposed off.

4. Needless to say that, the petitioner shall be at liberty to move an

appropriate application for alteration of charge before the competent Court of law, in accordance with law.

5. All other, pending applications, if any, are also disposed off, accordingly.
