2. Heard counsel for the petitioner.
3. Concededly, petitioner was granted regular bail on 25.07.2008. He absented from the proceedings and was declared as a proclaimed offender on 08.10.2009, Annexure P-2.
4. Instant petition seeking grant of anticipatory bail is not maintainable, in view of the legal position as settled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Manish Jain Versus Haryana State Pollution Control Board, 2020 (20) SCC 123*.
