1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to direct respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case GD No.028 dated 26.02.2022 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 323/325/148/149 IPC in FIR No.31 dated 10.02.2022 under Sections 324/341/427/323/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar Rural against the accused persons.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but her grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural-respondent No.2, by way of her representation dated

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14.09.2023, Annexure P-4, but the same is also pending decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the record of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural-respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 14.09.2023, Annexure P-4 and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two months from today

5. In view of the above, the present petition stands disposed of.
