1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.331 of 2019 under Sections 323, 325, 328, 506 and 34 of the IPC registered at Police Station Sector 5, Panchkula as warrant of arrest has been issued against her by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Panchkula vide order dated 07.02.2022 (Annexure P-2).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner at the outset prays for withdrawal of the instant petition. However, he submits that since the petitioner is willing and ready to appear, and surrender before the Trial Court, the petitioner be protected till her appearance before the Trial Court and with directions to the Trial Court that her bail application, which she would be filing on her surrender, be decided expeditiously.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is directed to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today. Till then, no coercive

steps be taken against the petitioner.

5. It is made clear that in case, the petitioner fails to surrender before the Trial Court within 07 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to her, thereafter. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioner moves an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court, in accordance with law.
