The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.143 dated 16.08.2023 registered under Sections 458/380/427/148 and 149 IPC at Police Station Sadar Fazilka, District Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 12.10.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 05.12.2023 by way of an affidavit of Shubeg Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Fazilka has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 12.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
