The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.136 dated 01.10.2020, under Sections 323, 324, 307, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, registered at Police Station Jhander, District Amritsar .

Vide order dated 21.11.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 21.11.2022 , petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI – Angrej Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 21.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
