The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0207 dated 01.09.2021 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Moti Nagar, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim orders dated 17.10.2023 and 03.10.2023 in CRM-M-49193-2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the orders dated 17.10.2023 and 03.10.2023 in CRM-M-49193-2023 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 17.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
