RITU BAHRI, ACTING CHIEF JUSTICE. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for respondent No.7 had stated before this Court on 14.11.2023, that respondent No.7 was not aware that she could not claim the benefit of Scheduled Caste certificate, which was acquired by her after her marriage. Respondent No. 7 belongs to general category.

Keeping in view this statement, the admission of respondent No.7 against Scheduled Caste category has to be cancelled by the competent authority in accordance with law. As far as the case of the present petitioner is concerned, she is at Sr. No. 6907 and there were only two seats for Scheduled Caste category, respondent No.7 had a rank of 1342. No case is

made out to grant admission to the petitioner at par with respondent No.7 who has already given up her seat.

Accordingly, the writ petition is being dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to take steps in accordance with law if anybody lower in rank than the petitioner (6907 as per Annexure P-6) is given seat.
