Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.102 dated 08.08.2022, under Sections 427, 447, 380 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Maqsudan, Jalandhar.

Vide order dated 22.11.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by counsel for the petitioners that petitioner No.1-Surinder Singh has already expired. However, pursuant to order dated 22.11.2022, petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has affirmed the fact that petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 22.11.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
