At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the petition on the ground that instant revision petition arises from proceedings under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, which have been finally concluded vide judgment and decree dated 31.03.2023. It is submitted that in view of the same, the present petition has been rendered infructuous. In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has been instructed to withdraw this petition.

Learned counsel for the respondent affirms the aforesaid submission and has supplied a copy of the judgment and decree dated 31.03.2023 whereby Principal Judge, Family Court, Hisar, has accepted the petition filed under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act and passed a decree of divorce dissolving the marriage of the petitioner with the respondent.

In the light of the above, the present petition having been rendered infructuous, the prayer for withdrawal of the petition is allowed.
