The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for grant of bail pending trial in case FIR No.0029 dated 13.03.2021 registered at Police Station Guru Harsahai, District Ferozepur under section 302 IPC (Section 506 IPC added later on).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the attribution to the petitioner is only giving a *sota* blow on the arms of the deceased. The petitioner is in custody since 29.11.2021 and there is no other case pending against him. Therefore, he may be released on bail pending trial. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the alleged witness examined by the prosecution has not supported the case of the prosecution.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, being instructed by SI Gurdeep Kaur, submits that the petitioner is directly involved in the alleged incident and father of the petitioner was killed by the petitioner and his brother. The eye witness was none other than the uncle of

the petitioner. However, it is not disputed that the injury attributed to the petitioner is only on the arms of the deceased. It is also not disputed that the eye witness has not supported the case of the prosecution and that the petitioner is in custody since 15.03.2021.

4. In view of the above, but without expressing any further opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail pending trial subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
