1. Prayer in this writ petition is for quashing notice dated 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-2) issued by respondent No.3 under Section 13(4) of Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act (SARFAESI Act), 2002 Act.
