JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 13.10.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of the order dated 20.09.2023 (Annexure P-4) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur vide which the bail granted by the Trial Court has been cancelled and the bail bonds and surety bonds was ordered to be forfeited to the State pursuant to the non bailable warrants of arrest have been issued.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contends that on account of noting down of a wrong date, the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioners are ready and willing to join proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 09.11.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Chandi Kusht Ashram Society, Shiv Ram Mandir (Leprosy Colony), Sector 47,

Opp. 3 BRD Gate, Chandigarh and on their doing they shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioners shall place on record a copy of the receipt depositing the amount of Rs.25,000/- as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioners.”

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of the aforementioned order the petitioners have surrendered and have since been granted the concession of interim bail. They have also deposited the costs as imposed by this Court vide order dated 13.10.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioners shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent themselves without any sufficient cause.
