Status report by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Narnaul, District Mahendergarh has been filed on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 3-State in Court today and the same is taken on record.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus to recover the alleged detenue, namely Varsha Yadav, who has been illegally and forcibly detained by respondents No.4 and 5.

In compliance of the last order dated 11.10.2023, the alleged detenu, namely, Varsha Yadav has been produced before this Court.

I have interacted with the alleged detenue, namely, Varsha Yadav in the Court. She submits that she was happily staying with respondents No.4 and 5 and was not illegally confined by them. However, she is aged about 21 years and wants to go with the petitioner.

Since she is major and well educated, she is permitted to go to the place of her choice. The present petition is accordingly, disposed of.
