The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0189 dated 31.05.2023 under Sections 448, 380 and 201 (Section 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Islamabad, Amritsar.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.10.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 12.10.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 12.10.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
