HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner be given liberty to approach the respondents to claim the minimum of the pay scale keeping in view the instructions issued by the respondents on 03.11.2017 by filing appropriate representation and the respondents be directed to pass appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner so that the petitioner does not suffer any prejudice.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner claiming any relief, the same will be disposed of in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation and in case after the decision of the representation, any benefit accrues to the petitioner, the same will be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further, at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to file representation.
