1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash the order dated 22.06.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No. 2, whereby, the proceedings under Section 145 Cr.P.C. were ordered to be initiated in the present case by the Court of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Samana, District Patiala.

2. During the pendency of the present petition, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and now the matter has been amicably resolved by the parties vide settlement/compromise deed dated 19.09.2023.

3. Learned counsel for the parties submit that all the disputes, which were pending in different Courts/Forums of law have been resolved by them and it was agreed between the parties that the

proceedings under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. will be quashed on the basis of the compromise between the parties. Learned counsel for the parties, on instructions from their respective clients, who are present in the Court, submit that both the parties shall remain bound by the terms of the compromise.

4. In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the parties and the terms of the compromise/settlement dated 19.09.2023, the proceedings under Sections 145/146 Cr.P.C. and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby ordered to be quashed.

5. The petition is disposed off in above terms.

6. Needless to observe that the petitioner as well as the respondents 3 and 4 shall remain bound by the terms of the compromise/settlement deed.
