This is the second petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 22.04.2018, registered under Sections 22 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station City South, District Moga.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, on instructions from SI Balwinder Singh, has submitted that all the prosecution witnesses have since been examined. Even the affidavit of Gursharanjit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (City), Moga, on behalf of the respondent has been produced before this Court, in this regard. The same is taken on record.

Since all the prosecution witnesses have been examined, therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail pending trial, at this stage.
