Prayer in the present petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.3 i.e. Tehsildar SAS Nagar (Mohali) to pass any appropriate order in accordance with law in pursuance to application dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-13) filed by the petitioner whereby it has been prayed that the mutation of the properties of the firm namely R&H Enterprises, which have been listed as residue properties after the due settlement of accounts of the firm following its dissolution, be sanctioned in favour of its Partners i.e. petitioner and proforma respondent No.6 in equal share, which was in continuation of the previous application dated 29.04.2022 (Annexure P-9) filed by the petitioner before the Tehsildar, SAS Nagar, Mohali wherein after following the due procedure and seeking objections from the General Public regarding the aforesaid mutation, through newspaper publications dated 12.05.2022 (Annexures P-10 & P-11), the Tehsildar had issued an order/letter dated 09.06.2022

(Annexure P-12) directing the kanungo/patwari halaqa to implement the same in the revenue record, however the same has not been implemented till today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the redressal of his grievance, petitioner has filed application dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-13) before respondent No.3-Tehsildar, Tehsil & District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab but the same has not been taken into consideration by the said respondent till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

After hearing counsel for the parties and perusing the record, respondent No. 3-Tehsildar, Tehsil & District SAS Nagar, Mohali, Punjab is directed to decide the application dated 08.09.2023 (Annexure P-13) filed by the petitioner expeditiously preferably within four weeks from today in accordance with law.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of.
