VIKAS SURI, J. (Oral)

1. This is a petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondent No.4.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that an agreement to sell had been executed between the petitioner and respondent on 25.07.2022, but despite the date having been extended thrice to execute the Sale-deed, respondent No.4 did not come forward. It is alleged that respondent No.4 alongwith other persons has caused loss to the motor installed in the field and to the crop sown by the petitioner. Representation (Annexure P-2) is alleged to have been made to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala – respondent No.2, but to no avail.

3. A perusal of the paper-book would show that no date of the alleged occurrence or of the representation is forthcoming on the record.

4. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for liberty to file a detailed representation seeking protection of life and liberty afresh, on the same cause of action as in the present case.

5. Mr.Amish Sharma, AAG, Punjab puts in appearance on behalf of the officials respondents, pursuant to an advance copy of the petition having been sent in this case, and states that on receipt of fresh representation from the petitioner, the same would be looked into and appropriate action would be taken thereon, as warranted by law in the facts and circumstances.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or commenting thereon, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make a comprehensive representation to respondent No.2. On the petitioner doing so, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala – respondent No.2 is directed to dispose of the said representation, in accordance with law, within three weeks thereafter.
