The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.394 dated 18.08.2021, registered under Sections 166-A, 409. 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC, at Police Station, Civil Lines, Kaithal (Section 166-A IPC dropped during investigation).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.11.2022 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of custodial interrogation.

Mr. Rajinder Kumar, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, submits that in compliance of the interim order dated 23.11.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for the purpose of investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the grant of concession of bail to the petitioner.

However, in view of the observations made by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court in the interim order dated 23.11.2022 and also in view of the fact that the petitioner is no longer required for the purpose of investigation, the interim order dated 23.11.2022 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
