This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order dated 29.08.2022 (Annexure P-2); order dated 03.10.2022 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 15.11.2022 (Annexure P-7), vide which the petitioner has been directed to vacate the house.
