JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (ORAL)

On 17.10.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ The prayer in the present petition under Section 482 Cr.PC is for quashing of the order dated 22.08.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar vide which the bail orders of the petitioner were cancelled and his bail bonds and surety bonds had been forfeited to the State in case bearing FIR No.180 dated 26.08.2018 under Sections 365, 384, 392, 224, 115, 120-B and 411 IPC read with Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 alongwith Sections 21-22-61-85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Div. No.7, Jalandhar City, Punjab.

The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of the noting down of a wrong date, the petitioner was unable to appear on one date i.e. 22.08.2023 on which date the impugned order came to be passed. He states that the petitioner is ready and willing to join the proceedings once again.

Notice of motion for 04.12.2023.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender

before the Trial Court within a period of one week from today and subject to a deposit of Rs.25,000/- as costs with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh Lawyers Family Welfare Fund, Account No.41564846387, SBI High Court Branch, IFSC:-SBIN0050306, , he shall be admitted to interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to produce a copy of the receipt depositing Rs.25,000/- as well as a copy of the order granting interim bail to the petitioner on the next date of hearing. ”

On 02.11.2023 the following order was passed:-

“ CRM-45271-2023

The prayer in the application is for rectification/modification or having lenient view in ordered dated 17.10.2023 imposing the condition of depositing of cost of Rs.25,000/- to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh Lawyers Welfare Fund.

Heard.

No ground is made out.

Dismissed.

However, on oral request of the counsel for the petitioner, petitioner is granted one more opportunity to comply with the order dated 17.10.2023.

To come up on 04.12.2023 date already fixed.”

In compliance of the aforementioned orders the petitioner has surrendered on 02.12.2023 and has since been granted the concession of interim bail. He has also deposited the costs as imposed by this Court vide order dated 17.10.2023.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.

Disposed of.

However, it is made clear that the petitioner shall continue to appear before the Trial Court and shall not absent himself without any

sufficient cause.
