1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 5 not to call and harass the petitioner time and again in their offices, on the basis of false and frivolous complaints moved by respondent No.6.
2. In compliance of the last order dated 09.11.2023 passed by this Court, Mr. J.Elanchezhian, Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga-respondent No.5 is present in the Court along with entire relevant record. He has informed that all the complaints moved by respondent No.6 in the present case have been closed and the petitioner shall not be harassed by the police of Moga. He has also assured the Court that in case any information disclosing cognizable offence is received either against the petitioner or any other person, appropriate action shall be taken, in accordance with the provisions of law.
3. In view of the statement made by respondent No.3, no further orders are required to be passed and accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of.
