The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.202 dated 25.10.2022 registered under Sections 306 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Tibba, Ludhiana.

Since petitioner No.2-Jasvir Kaur has already been arrested, the present petition qua her was dismissed as having become infructuous vide order dated 23.11.2022 passed by this Court.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that in compliance with order dated 23.11.2022, petitioner No.1-Mohit Mittal has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition qua petitioner No.1-Mohit Mittal is allowed and the order dated 23.11.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner No.1-Mohit Mittal is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
