1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.151 dated 22.05.2022, under Section 174-A IPC, registered at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

2. In compliance of order dated 30.10.2023, learned counsel has placed on record copy of the order dated 20.10.2023 whereby the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court in furtherance to the order passed in CRM-M-52215-2023, by virtue of which, the order declaring him a proclaimed person was quashed by this Court. Learned counsel submits that the proclamation proceedings were initiated out in a complaint case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act,

1881, which also stands withdrawn vide order dated 04.12.2023.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bharat Raj, submits that the orders passed by the trial Court referred to above are matter of record and in the light of the same, custody of the petitioner is not required.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of directing the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court concerned within 02 weeks from today. On his doing so, he be enlarged on bail subject to his furnishing bail bond/surety to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
