

GIAN CHAND VS STATE OF PUNJAB & ORS

On 03.12.2014, the petitioner was directed to produce the latest seniority list. After granting various opportunities to the learned counsel representing the petitioner, the writ petition was adjourned sine die vide order dated 29.04.2015. However, no effort was made to place on record the seniority list. Thereafter, the writ petition was taken up by the Court on 14.03.2017 and the last opportunity was granted while clearly indicating that if the petitioner fails to produce the seniority list, the writ petition shall stand dismissed for non-prosecution. Subsequently, the case has been adjourned on account of non-appearance of the learned counsel representing the petitioner.

In view of the order dated 14.03.2017, the writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
