1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus restraining the respondents from continuing with the departmental enquiry during the pendency of the criminal trial.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since there are mistakes in the petition and certain documents have not been annexed, the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after rectifying the said mistake and after annexing the relevant documents.
