HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. In the present writ petition, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that their salary is not being released since July, 2023 and that too without any valid justification, hence, the respondents are liable to be directed to release the salary of the petitioners forthwith.

2. On being asked as to whether, the petitioners have raised the said grievance with the respondents in any manner, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the oral request has been made but no written request has been made for the release of the salary before filing the present writ petition.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners will file an appropriate representation raising the grievance as raised in the present writ petition and the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner so that the petitioners do not suffer any further prejudice.

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

6. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioners raising any grievance, the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of the receipt of such representation and in case after the passing of the speaking order, any relief is to be extended to the petitioners, the same will also be extended to them within a further period of two weeks.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation.

8. Ordered accordingly.
