1. This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 18.03.2020 conveyed on 07.09.2022 (Annexure P-19).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that as per the case of the petitioner, the petitioner had applied under the Hindu category whereas the petitioner's merit list which has been supplied under the RTI Act shows that the petitioner is at Sr. No.10 in a different category and thus, he seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Civil Writ Petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition challenging the said merit list if so, advised.
3. In view of the above, the present Civil Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
4. In case any such petition is filed, then the same would be considered independently on its own merits and in accordance with law.
