This revision is against acquittal. The two respondents were acquitted by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Hisar vide judgment dated 13.02.2019 in case arising out of FIR No.473 dated 07.06.2013 registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar under Sections 285, 506 of the IPC & Section 27/54/59 of Arms Act.

2. The said acquittal was challenged by the complainant by filing the appeal before the Sessions Court but appeal was dismissed vide judgment dated 02.11.2022.

3. It is contended by learned counsel that after recording acquittal on the basis of compromise, the respondents are misbehaving with the petitioner.

4. The contention raised by learned counsel for the petitioner for setting aside the impugned judgment of acquittal, which has been upheld by

the Appellate Court, has absolutely no merit. Simply because the respondents are misbehaving with the petitioner after acquittal as is alleged by the petitioner cannot be the ground to set aside the acquittal.

5. Learned counsel could not point out any illegality or irregularity in the impugned judgments passed by the Courts below in acquitting the respondents.

6. Finding no merit in the revision, same is hereby dismissed.
