The petitioner, who is the complainant in FIR No. 143 dated 22.08.2021, registered under Sections 420, 354, 498-A, 406, 506, 34, 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Sector 9, Ambal City, Ambala, alleges violation of the directions/guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Arnesh Kumar vs. State of Bihar & another, 2014 (8) SCC 73*.

Admittedly, the petitioner/complainant has already filed a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. against the investigation being carried out by the Investigating Officer or higher police officials, however, it is alleged that there is a violation of the directions/guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar's* case (supra).

On the face of it, the directions issued in *Arnesh Kumar's* case (supra) are with regard to some protection given to an accused person i.e. to issue a notice under Section 41 Cr.P.C. as and when a person is sought to be arrested for an offence providing sentence less than seven years.

The entire argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioner

is that the respondents-authorities are not following the proper procedure as the statement of the accused has not been recorded immediately after registration of the FIR and it is recorded after a period of more than one month and also that Section 356 IPC, which was initially added, stands deleted during investigation.

Be whatsoever, since the petitioner has already filed a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for the redressal of her grievances, no case of contempt or willful disobedience is made out.

The present petition is dismissed accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.
